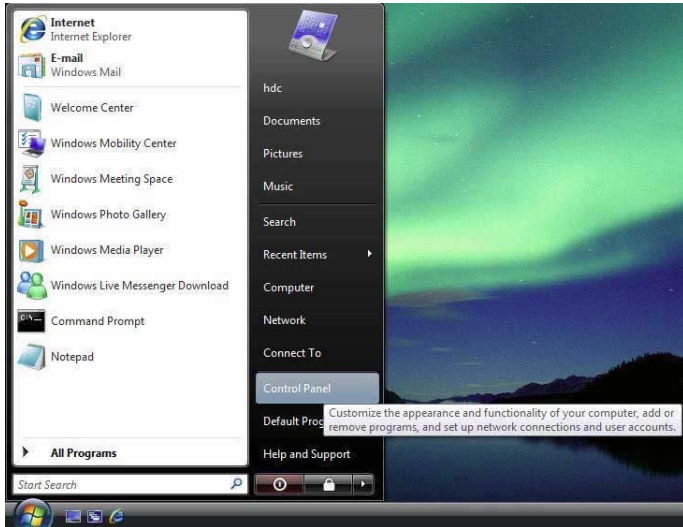
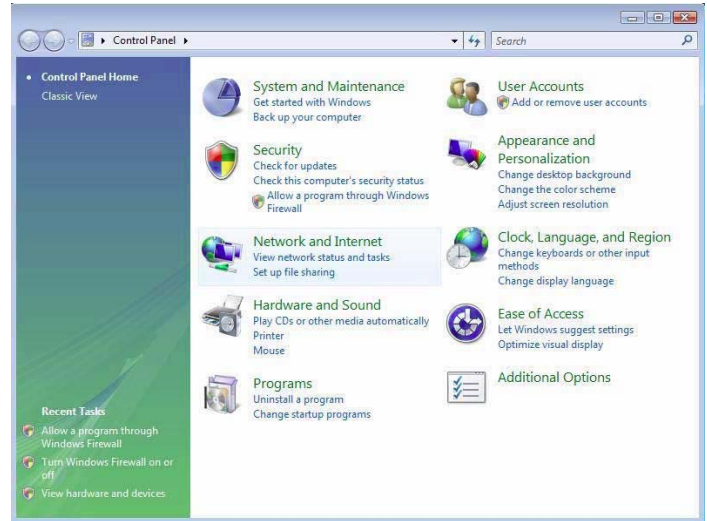


# Windows Vista – Setting up a Dial-up Connection

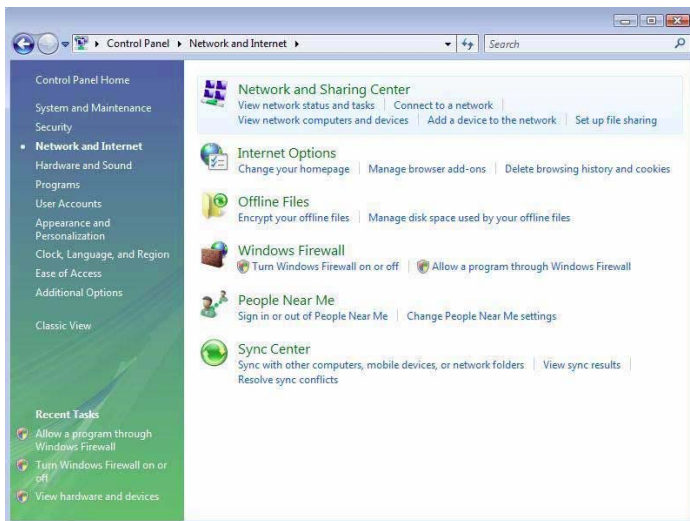
1. Go to the *Control Panel* from the Start Menu



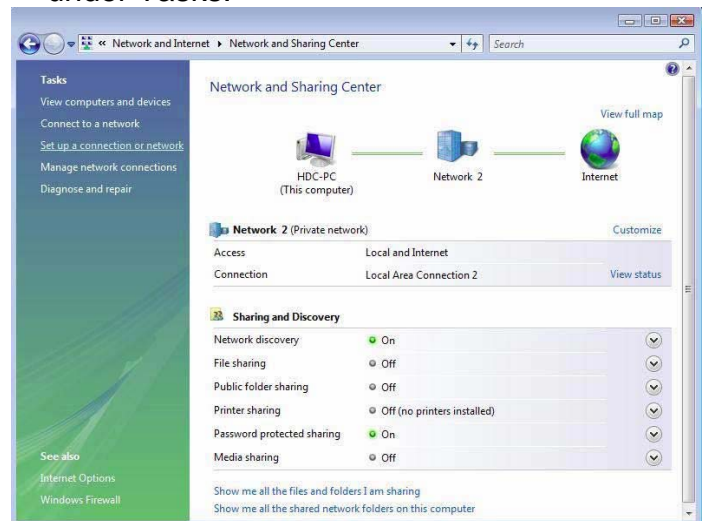
2. Click on "Network and Internet"



3. Click on "Network and Sharing Center"

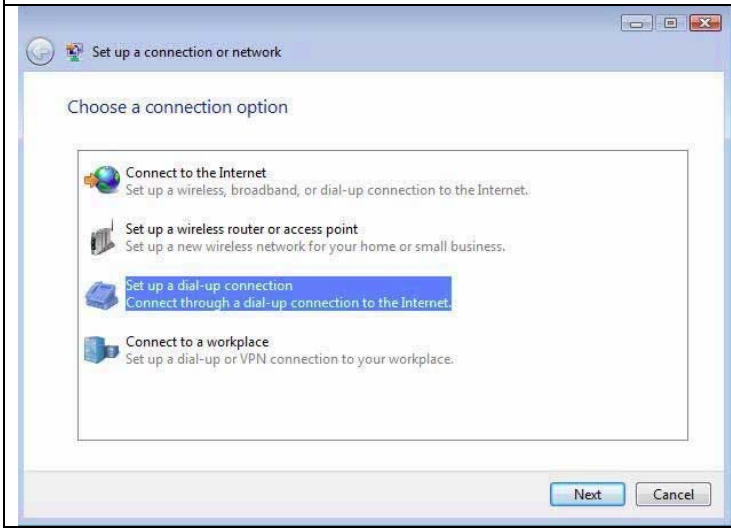


4. Click on "Set up a connection or network" under Tasks.

6. Use the following configuration settings

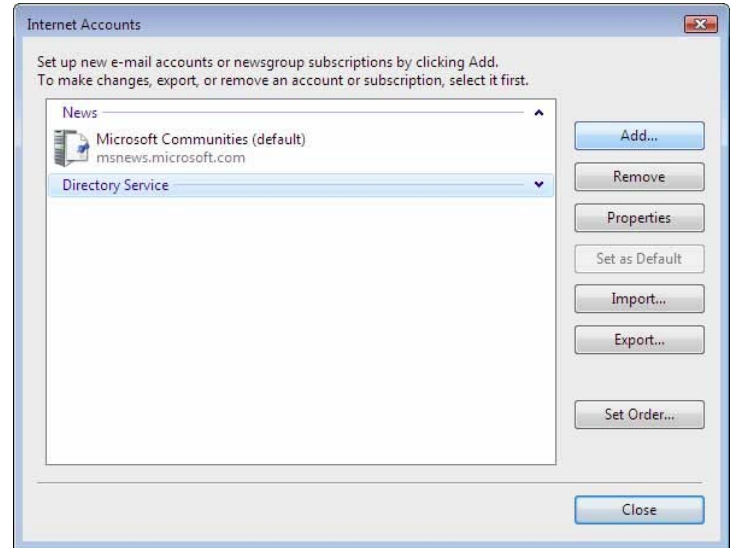
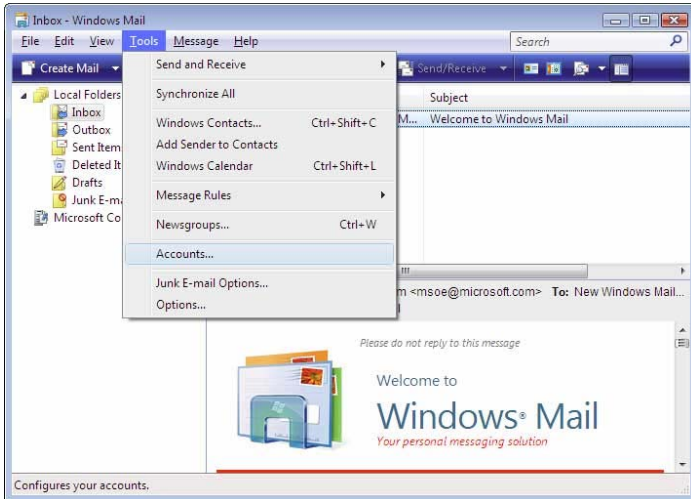

# Windows Vista – Setting up an E-mail Account

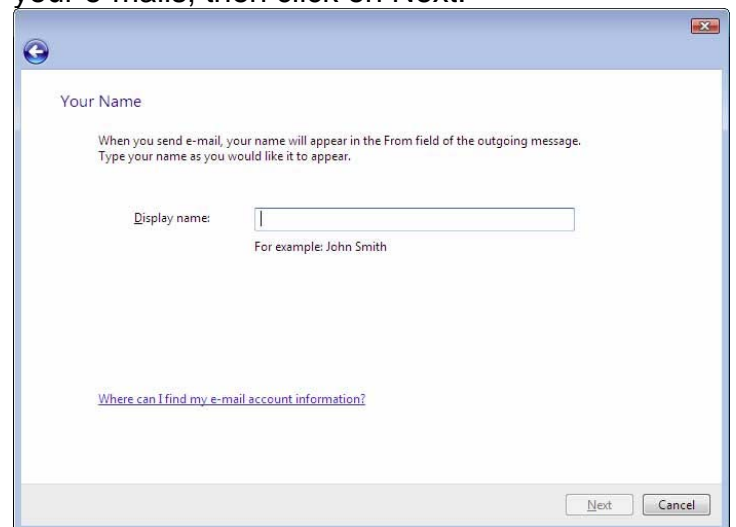
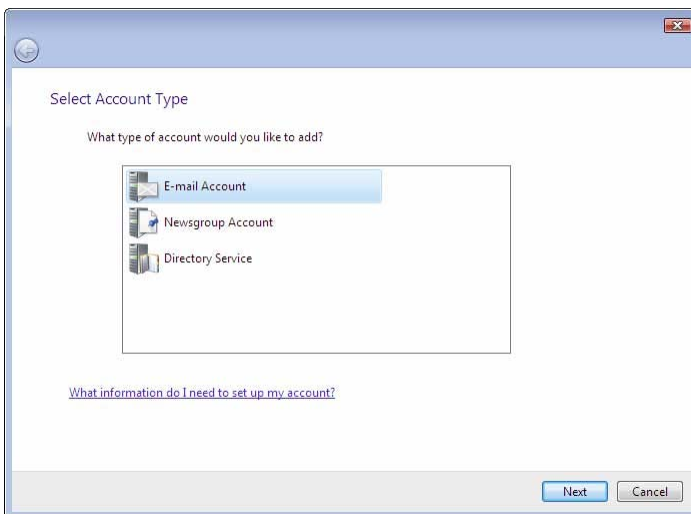
1. In Windows Mail, go to the Tools menu and click on Accounts...

2. Click on the Add button in the upper right.




3. In the Select Account Type window, double-click on E-mail Account.


4. In the Your Name window, type in the name you want your recipients to see when they receive your e-mails, then click on Next.




5. In the Internet E-mail Address window, type in your e-mail address, then click on Next.



6. In the Set up e-mail servers window, enter the e-mail server information as shown below, using pop3.kmtel.com for the Incoming and smtp.kmtel.com for the Outgoing mail server.



7. In the Internet Mail Logon window, enter your username and password for your e-mail account
