How to Use watchTVeverywhere

If you already have a watchTVeverywhere account:

- Go to www.wtve.net.
- · Click the Log In link.
- Enter your username and password.
- Select the TV network you want to watch to see a list of available programs.

If you do not have a watchTVeverywhere-account and need to register:

- Go to www.wtve.net and select KMTelecom in the drop-down menu.
- Click the Register link.
- Complete the registration form.
- Check your email. You will receive a message with an activation link.
- Click on the link to complete the registration process





When streaming services like Netflix began, they all offered a free trial, hoping that once you watched their content you'd become a monthly subscriber. While this sales strategy is slowly becoming less common —Netflix has discontinued it—there are still streaming services that let you try them out without paying a cent.

Again, a free trial is the best route to take.

Keep in mind that to use these free trials, you'll probably need to enter credit card information. Some streaming services will automatically renew after the trial period is over, so set a reminder for yourself to cancel before this date if you don't plan to keep the service.

National Dairy Month Spotlights Food and Farmers

June is National Dairy Month. It began as National Milk Month in 1937 as a way to promote drinking milk when production was at a surplus. After the National Dairy Council stepped in to promote the cause, the name changed to the broader National Dairy Month. It not only celebrates the benefits of dairy products but also recognizes the hard work of dairy farmers.

Dairy products include milk, cheese, and yogurt, and they provide essential nutrients including calcium, protein, potassium, and vitamin A. Making them part of your diet may help you to better manage your weight, build muscle tissue, and reduce your risk for high blood pressure and osteoporosis.

Here are a couple of "udderly" amazing facts about dairy cows:

- Dairy cows drink more than 50 gallons of water a day.
- On average, cows produce 7 to 9 gallons of milk a day or around 128 glasses.

811 is the national call-before-you-dig phone number. Before you plan to dig, you should call 811 to request that buried utilities be marked with paint or flags. That way, you won't unintentionally dig into an underground utility line.

Do I really need to call?

Yes! Even projects you might consider small, like planting flowers or a shrub, require you to call 811. Many utilities are buried just a few inches below ground and can be easily damaged by a shovel. You also need to call before installing a mailbox, fence, or patio. Even if you had an area marked a few years ago, call 811 again if you're planning to do additional digging there, since erosion and root system growth can alter the depth or location of buried lines. Your utility companies may also have completed work on their lines since the last time you dug.

When do I call 811?

You should call 811 a few business days before you begin any digging project. The specific amount of advance notice that you're required to provide varies by state.

What information do I need to provide?

You'll need to tell the 811 center the address of where you plan to dig, including the county and nearest cross street, as well as the type of project you're planning and the area on the property where you're planning to dig. If you're only planning to dig in a small area and don't want your entire yard marked, you can outline the area in white paint or white flags available at home improvement stores.

What do I do after I call 811?

You need to wait a few days to allow all utilities to respond to your request. Once they've marked their buried lines, you may begin digging. Dig carefully around any utility marks, not on them. You may want to consider relocating projects that are close to buried utilities.
